The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) would like to extend its appreciation for your patience and understanding, while we are working on the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage project.

As part of the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage project, the contractor began road testing in the Ordway Street NW alley behind Sam's Park & Shop and this process includes temporary alley restrictions (7:00 am – 7:00 pm) for businesses receiving deliveries and trash pickup. We will make every effort to coordinate with trash companies so that trash is collected on a regular schedule, and we ask that you coordinate with your delivery companies to work within the given parameters.

As a reminder, stairs will need to be removed by the contractor from the rear of CityPaws and Toe Tally Nails on Wednesday, May 18, 2022 for approximately 3-5 business days, then will be placed back.

Traffic controls will be in place to guide motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians safely through/around the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert, be observant of signage and expect delays while traveling in this area.
